

VETERAN MEMORIAL WALK

At the last Brasher Town meeting further development of the Veteran Memorial Park was discussed. I suggested making a brick walk along the riverbank which the board approved. Each brick will have the name of a Veteran that served our country from the WAR OF 1812 to present. This project has the same criteria as the plaque, veteran must have been schooled in the S.L.C district or a resident of the area. The bricks cost \$20.00 each, 2,500 names are anticipated. The employees of NUMED have generously donated \$50,000 for this project. Labor will be performed by volunteers. The Town of Brasher will be assisting in this and other additions to the park.

Information desired: rank, name, branch, years served and duty station. For example; SP4 James A. Stickney 1972-1974 Germany. Also note if they were Killed in Action, MIA, or received a Purple Heart, Bronze Star, etc. Provide what information you have, it can be edited to fit the brick.
